

- 762 respondents as of end of day Wednesday, July 22


Respondent Demographics

What school(s) will your child(ren) attend in Fall 2020? (check all that apply) 762 responses




Respondent Demographics (continued)

What grade(s) is your child(ren) entering for Fall 2020? Check all that apply. 762 responses




Return to School Stable Cohort or Full Distance Learning

Based on what you know today, which learning option are you more comfortable with for Fall 2020? (We understand that specifics have not been published yet.) ⁷⁶² responses





My child(ren) will remain in full distance learning for the entire fall semester (note: for families enrolled in SUSD last year, there is a chance your child may not be able to return back to the same school as last year depending on enrollment and class sizes at time of reentry).

Return to School Stable Cohort or Full Distance Learning




Option 1: Return to school when safe 🛛 🔴 Option 2: Full Distance Learning


Hybrid Model: A/B or AM/PM




- Hybrid A/B: children attend school on campus part of the week, Monday & Tuesday OR Thursday & Friday

Hybrid Model: A/B or AM/PM




Hybrid Model: A/B or AM/PM



Set Weekly Schedule



Whole Group vs. Small Group


In distance learning, in general does your child prefer interaction with the entire class (whole group) or small groups?


Flipped Classroom

 - Need help rooms and office hours


Small Groups for In-Person Meeting with Teacher
